23rd Annual Horse & Hound Jr/Am Medal Finals

First Round - Class 1
Second Round - Class 2
Overall Champion - Class 3
Entry Fee \$100

Open to riders accumulating at least 5 points in the Horse & Hound Medal qualifying class since the 2022 Finals.

To be shown over two rounds of fences 3' in height. Round 2 will include 2 tests as part of the course. First round is a drawn order by qualifiers; Second round comes back in reverse score order low to high, and all qualifiers will ride both rounds and ribbons 1st thru 10th will be awarded at the completion of each round. The top 10 scores overall will ride for awards & ribbons. Two judges will be used and scores announced after each round. Scores from both rounds will be averaged for a final score.

Any rider(s) within 3 points of the top score will be required to work off. Work off, if any, to be determined by the judges.

Riders who have competed in any 3'6 Medal Finals in the past 3 years are ineligible to compete.

20th Annual Horse & Hound Pony Medal Finals

First Round - Class 4 - 2' Class 5 - 2'6
Second Round - Class 6 - 2' Class 7 - 2'6
Overall Champion - Class 8
Entry Fee \$100

Open to riders accumulating at least 3 points in the Horse & Hound Medal qualifying class since the 2022 Finals.

To be shown over two rounds of approx. 8 fences (Small/Medium to jump 2' & Large to jump 2'6). Round 2 will include 2 tests as part of the course. First round is a drawn order by qualifiers; Second round comes back in reverse score order low to high, and all qualifiers will ride both rounds and ribbons 1st thru 10th will be awarded at the completion of each round.

The top 10 scores overall will ride for awards & ribbons. Two judges will be used and scores announced after each round. Scores from both rounds will be averaged for a final score.

Any rider(s) within 3 points of the top score will be required to work off. Work off, if any, to be determined by the judges.

(Round 1 - Sm/Med will jump first; Round 2 - Large will jump first).



\$20,000 Autumn Classic Grand Prix

The Autumn Classic Grand Prix to be scored under Table II, Section 2b. Fences to be set at 1.25m to 1.30m with a minimum of three obstacles in which the spread exceeds the height by 5 cm (2") up to 15 cm (6"). Prize money and ribbons to 8th; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.

\$7,500 Autumn Classic Welcome

The Jumper Welcome to be scored under Table II, Section 2b. Fences to be set at 1.20m with a minimum of three obstacles in which the spread exceeds the height by 5 cm (2") up to 15 cm (6"). Prize money and ribbons to 8th; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.



\$20,000 FoxFarms Open Hunter Derby

The FoxFarms Hunter Derby is a two round competition, emphasizing, brilliance of performance, manners, handiness and style, judged over three different heights (2'9, 3' and 3'3). The first & second round to be shown over a course of at least 8 jumps which must include a bending line, two stride in & out, a long approach, natural jumps, a trot jump (only in one round) and an option that presents itself as a more difficult track. The top eight scores will come back for the second round and will jump at their respective heights. Riders scores from the first round will be averaged with the second round score to determine the overall winner. Prize money and ribbons to 8th; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.

\$2,500 FoxFarms Jr/Am Hunter Derby

Open to non pros. A rider and/or horse may compete in both the Jr/Am & Open Hunter Derbies. Horse and rider combinations to jump a Classic round consisting of 5-6 fences then directly after the completion of the Classic round, horses will pass through a set of markers to begin the Handy portion of the class. The Handy round will consist of 4-5 fences, where pace, brilliance, and a shorter track are to be rewarded. Option fences may be used in either round. Riders score from the Classic round will be averaged with the Handy round score to determine the overall winner. Prize money and ribbons to 8th; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.

\$500 The Derby Challenge

Open to non pros. Rider must have not competed at this show over 2'6. The Derby Challenge is judged over three different heights (2', 2'3 and 2'6). Same specifications as the FoxFarms Jr/Am Hunter Derby.

Sections or under saddles with less than 3 Judged in a class, a Show Champion will not be awarded.

Jumper Champion

Championship points are based on - First-10 points, Second-6 points, Third-4 points, Fourth-2 points, Fifth-1 points, Sixth-1/2 point.

In case of a Championship Tie, Bonus Points in the first & Last class will be applied; First-15 points, Second-9 points, Third-6 points, Fourth-3 points, Fifth-2 points, Sixth-1 point.

JUMPER SECTIONS

Jumpers: In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be broken by the fastest time. Orders will be drawn per USEF JP112. Time allowed to be based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute for all jumper Sections. Sweaters or Shirts with a collar will be acceptable. Prize to 1st, Ribbons 1st-8th; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%. Jumper Classic Prize Money 1st-30%, 2nd-25%, 3rd-20%, 4th-15%, 5th-10%. **See Rule 38 for Featured Jumper Class Information. Classes with less than 3 course completion - Only ribbons will be awarded.**

7. **STALLS:** All horses on the show grounds must pay for a stall, a stall may be split between two horses for an additional \$150 fee (unable to split discounted Outreach Stalls). **Trainers will be responsible for payment of all horse & tack stalls requested after entries due date has passed. See Rule 11 for substituting a horse.** An open check or credit card authorization form is required to hold stalls. The Show Office handles all stall transactions and charges. Private transactions involving stalls are not permitted. Request for stalls for horses not entered in the show or for tack, feed or grooming may be reduced by management and refunds given. **NO STRAW ALLOWED.** Wood or Canvas construction: Top & bottom doors size stalls are 10 x 10, 10 X 12, 12 X 12 most with rubber mats. Anyone dismantling stalls or causing damage to a stall(s) will be charged a \$100 fee per panel, with a maximum fine of \$400 per stall.
8. **ENTRY PROCEDURES:** Entry blanks must be filled out completely, including all classes entered, COVID-19, EHV and VS materials, signatures and organizational membership numbers. Entry blanks must be postmarked on or before Tuesday, September 26, 2023 to receive Early Stall/Tack discount. After Tuesday, September 26, 2023 Post Entries are accepted. For each horse entered, a check or credit card for a deposit of \$200 must be included. All horses on the grounds must have a number, even non-showing horses. Numbers will not be issued without a check or credit card covering the balance of the entries.
 - Credit cards (Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express): Card holder will be charged an additional 4% over the published rates as the rates shown in the Prize List are discounted for paying by cash, check or money order. If paying by credit card, upon receipt of the entry blank, and/or credit card authorization form, Horse Show Management will charge the credit card for the Competition registration fees. Credit cards shall be presented to Horse Show Management in the office before or at the time of close out. If such card is not presented or an alternative method of payment is not made, Rider/Trainer/Owner agrees that Horse Show Management is authorized to charge the credit card pursuant to the information contained in the entry blank at the conclusion of the Competition.
 - Cash, Check or Money Order Payments: The rates in this Prize List reflect the 4% discount if paying by cash, check or money order. If paying by check, cash, or money order please submit the required payment, made payable to FoxFarms, Inc., with a complete entry blank for each showing or non-showing entry, on or by the published Entries Due.
9. **REGISTRATION FEE & ADD/SCRATCH POLICY:** Registration Fee allows unlimited Adds/Scratches the day before the scheduled class except for Featured Classes (see Rule 38) and astrid (***) marked Hunter Divisions (see rule 13D). Same day Adds will pay a \$5 add fee, same day Scratches will pay a \$10 scratch fee. Adds/Scratches must be done on an Add/Scratch Form or Trainer Form in the Horse Show Office. Horses scratching the show after the entries due will pay a scratch fee of \$375. Horses scratched at the show will pay \$450 and can be used as an additional tack stall unless substituting a horse see Rule 11.
10. **OPEN ARENA FEE:** Allows Competitors to ride in the arenas all day Tuesday, and as arenas are available before the show. See Rule 39 for arena lights. Jumper rings close 1 hour before the start, and hunters 30 to 45 minutes before start of show.
11. **HORSE SUBSTITUTION POLICY:** After Entries Due substituting a scratched horse with another horse within the same Trainer's barn is allowed, the substituted horse will pay a substitution fee of \$25 in addition to all other fees. The scratched horse will pay a scratch fee of \$125. No substituting allowed after a horse has shown. This policy applies to USHJA Outreach scratched horses also.
ALL SUBSTITUTION MUST BE DONE BEFORE THE START OF THE SHOW.
12. **ENTRY BLANKS:** Care should be taken to enter each horse in its proper division or class. Competitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents completing entry blanks. In all cases the description on the entry blank must fully identify the horse. The word "entry" shall not be accepted.
 - A. Be properly signed, and in the case of a minor, be signed by a parent or guardian.
 - B. Be made on an entry blank provided by the show.
 - C. Show the correct mailing address of the Owner, Trainer and Rider. Changes made after the completion of the show will be charged a Change Fee of \$50.
 - D. Social Security number must be included on entry blank, if not prize money will not be issued.
 - E. Include USEF membership card for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer and rider.
 - F. Include USHJA membership card or pay \$30 show pass for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer & rider.
 - G. Include all additional membership numbers and birth dates of junior and amateur riders. Please attach photocopy of USEF amateur card.
 - H. All Junior Hunters, Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters and Pony Jumpers must have a USEF measurement card.
 - I. Include Microchip number on the entry blank.
 - J. A show deposit of \$200 per horse must be included with entry.
 - K. Include signed COVID-19 and EHV Release and Protocol's by rider, parent, trainer and groom as required.
 - L. Entries received at the show a rush fee of \$45 will be applied.

13. **REFUND POLICY:** All refund requests must be submitted in writing.
- Before entries due, Tuesday, September 26, 2023, all paid fees will be credited or refunded.
 - After entries due, the show and RV deposit will not be refunded.
 - After the first class is completed in a astrid (**) marked Hunter Division no refunds will be issued.
 - After entries due, no refunds will be given unless you meet one of the following:
 - After the show starts, if a Competitor is ill or injured and cannot compete in the balance of the classes, that Competitor will be entitled to a refund of unused class fees provided the classes are officially scratched and a doctor's certificate is provided to the Horse Show Office prior to the close of the show.
 - After the show starts, if a horse is ill or injured classes scratched the same day they are scheduled receive a refund with an Official Show Veterinarian Certificate provided to the Horse Show Office prior to the close of the show.
 - No request for refunds will be accepted after the close of the show. (includes USHJA Outreach Classes)
14. **RETURNED CHECKS:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled in the following procedure. 10% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH RETURNED CHECK OR MINIMUM OF \$50. Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash, or cash equivalent or they will be turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action.
15. **CREDIT CARD CHARGEBACK:** Chargebacks for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be immediately turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action. 20% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CREDIT CARD CHARGE WILL BE ASSESSED OR MINIMUM OF \$300.
16. **UNPAID CHARGES:** If the Show Management or Show Official (i.e. farrier, veterinarian, feed supplier, photographer, food concessionaire, etc.) must bill a Competitor/Owner for unpaid charges, a \$50 billing fee will be added to the amount due.
- Past unpaid balances** – Competitor/Owner will be notified of any previous balance at the time of check-in. Outstanding balances must be paid prior to picking up show numbers. Horse Show Management reserves the right to require a deposit paid to cover all show expenses and any portion of the deposit that is unused will be mailed to the addressee on file no later than 15 days after the close of the show.
 - Unpaid Balances** – Competitor/Owner who do not come into the office to close out by 5pm at the end of the show forfeit the right to adjustments on any show charges. Final balances will be automatically charged to the payment method on file.
17. **PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money will not be deducted from the show bill, prize money will be made payable to the Payee or Owner listed if indicated on the Entry blank and mailed within 30 days after the show.
- PRIZE MONEY WILL NOT BE MAILED UNLESS THE OWNER OR PAYEE'S SOCIAL SECURITY/TAX ID NUMBER IS LISTED ON THE ENTRY BLANK. REQUESTS MADE WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL INCUR A \$100 FEE TO BE DEDUCTED FROM THE PRIZE MONEY. ALL CHECKS REQUESTED AND/OR NOT CASHED WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL RECEIVE A CREDIT FOR A FUTURE SHOW.
 - ANY CHECK REQUESTS DUE TO AN INCORRECT ADDRESS ON ENTRY BLANK - A STOP PAYMENT WILL BE PLACE ON THE INITIAL CHECK AND \$150 WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE PRIZE MONEY.
 - REQUESTING 1099 CHANGES AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN MAILED WILL BE CHARGED \$125 TO BE PAID IN ADVANCE.
- PRIZE MONEY WON BY FOREIGN COMPETITORS: Foreign competitors are advised that the U.S. Internal Revenue Service requires sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money won in the United States. Foreign competitors should apply for a U.S. Social Security number and will be asked to complete form W-8BEN prior to the Murieta Autumn Classics (FoxFarms, Inc.) issuing prize money won.
- Altering Jumper Prize Money - see Rule 52.**
18. **ADD-BACK:** In classes with add-back, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show.
19. **ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: *Horses arriving and/or departing before and/or after these dates & times will be billed \$25 per day per horse.***
- Arrive no earlier than Monday, 12pm October 16, 2023, Depart by 7pm Sunday, October 22, 2023.
- If VS Protocols are in place, then horse(s) must arrive only between the hours of 12pm - 5pm on Monday and 8am - 5pm Tuesday - Sunday, by appointment.***
- Please check for updated information at www.murietaautumnclassic.com***
20. **PARKING:** Horse trailers will be parked in designated areas. Autos will also be parked in designated areas. There will be no autos allowed in the barn area and aisles.
21. **RV's:** Weekly rate of \$450 30amps, \$500 50amps, \$550 30amps, w/sewer, please book your RV space at www.murietaautumnclassic.com, if cancelled before the entries due date a credit will be provided for current or future show. The RV deposit of \$125 is non-refundable after entries due date. **RV'S ARRIVING WITHOUT A RESERVATION WILL PAY AN ADDITIONAL \$100 OVER THE WEEKLY RATE, AS SPACE ALLOWS. RV'S arriving and/or departing before and/or after the scheduled dates & times will be billed a minimum of \$50 per day. See Rule 19.**
22. **FEED AND BEDDING:** All orders must be made through the Horse Show Office (916) 305-8898.
23. **MEDICAL WASTE:** Needles must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by Show Management.
24. **MEASURING OF ENTRIES:** Time of measuring will be posted in the Horse Show Office. ALL HUNTER AND JUMPER PONIES AND JUNIOR HUNTERS MUST HAVE A COPY OF OR THEIR ORIGINAL MEASUREMENT CARDS PRESENTED TO ONE OF THE SHOW SECRETARIES OR BE MEASURED IF THE CARD IS NOT AVAILABLE, BEFORE THE COMPETITORS' NUMBER WILL BE RELEASED.
25. **MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** USEF GR1301.7 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
26. **NUMBERS:** Management will provide a number card for each competitor which shall be worn on the rider's back clearly visible to the judge at all times when in competition. Riders wearing the wrong number or no number at all may be eliminated from the class by the judge.
27. **COURSES:** Courses may consist of any combination of the following: Brush, Gate, Oxers, Panels, Post & Rails, Banks, Ditches, Coups, Logs, Barrels & Liverpools. The horse show management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads in jumper classes as competition warrants.
28. **POLING:** Not allowed in California.
29. **HARD HATS:** USEF GR801.2 It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.
30. **SAFETY:** Accidents involving Competitors. GR849. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the Competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the Competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The Competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule.

31. **DOGS:** USEF GR1301.6 - Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card and may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
32. **SCHOOLING SUPERVISION:** Please be advised that paddock stewards are schooling supervisors and have absolute authority to scratch riders who do not follow USEF schooling rules. They can scratch riders without going through the USEF Steward or the Horse Show Manager.
33. **TIME SCHEDULE/POSTED ORDER:** Each day by 7pm the next day's time schedule will be available on www.horseshowing.com. This time schedule and/or posted orders will be strictly adhered to. The Trainer, Competitor or other representative must tell the paddock steward of possible ring conflicts so that arrangements can be made to accommodate the rider as well as the time schedule. All management decisions will be final. Order of go will be drawn according to USEF Rule JP111.2.
34. **ARENAS:** All show and warm-up arenas consist of GGT footing.
Jumper 1 - 120' X 240' Hunter 1 - 105' X 240' Hunter 2 - 105' X 240' Jumper 2/Hunter 3 120' X 250'
35. **HAUL INS:** All horses on the show grounds must pay for a stall.
36. **NON SHOWING POLICY:** For any horse on the grounds not officially entered, owner or trainer of said horse must complete an entry blank and write in the area of the Entry Blank used for classes "Non-Showing" and sign the entry blank at the Horse Show Office, pay a \$150 Non Showing Fee, Medic Fee, and a Stall Fee.
37. **2023 ZONE 10 SPECIFICATIONS:** Please see USHJA.org for current class specification with regards to; Children's Hunters, Adult Amateur Hunters, Pre-Green Hunter, Low Children's Jumpers, Low Adult Amateur Jumpers, Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers, Classics.
38. **FEATURED JUMPER, HUNTER & MEDAL CLASSES:**
- Horses entering the same day may be required to go first.
 - Featured Medal Classes added the same day will pay an additional post entry fee of \$5
 - Featured Classes added the same day will pay an additional post entry fee of \$50.
 - Featured Medal Classes scratched the same day will pay \$20
 - Featured Classes may only be scratched the day prior.
39. **ARENA LIGHTS:** Lights will be on in the GGT Arena & Stable Mix Wednesday through Sunday 6am - 7am.
40. **EQUINE VACCINATION RULE GR845:** At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. See USEF.org for outline of documentation required.
41. **HUNTER CLASSES:** Requiring a jog will trot a circle at the end of their round on a loose rein.
42. **OPEN HUNTER CLASSIC:** This is a two round hunter classic open to Green Hunters, 3', 3'3", 3'6", 3'9", High Performance Hunters, Performance Hunters 3'3" & 3'6". See USEF.org, Rule HU173. The last class of the division is the first round of the Open Hunter Classic.
43. **HUNTER CLASSICS:** Hunter Classics are two rounds. The last class of the division is the first round of the Hunter Classic.
44. **TRAINER SPLITS:** This service allows Trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until 5pm Friday any splits after Friday will subject to a \$5 office charge per entry. Only items billed by the horse show will be split. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected. FEED & BEDDING ORDERS AFTER 5pm FRIDAY WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE SPLIT AND WILL BE BILLED TO THE TRAINER.
45. **PRIZES/RIBBONS/PRIZE MONEY:** Classes awarding prize money must have at least three entries complete the course to pay, unless otherwise specified by USEF rules. Prize to 1st place, Ribbons 1st - 8th. Hunter Prize Money 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%. USHJA Outreach prizes and ribbons may differ from the Rated Show.
46. **HORSE NOMINATION:** All horses entered in the show must pay a \$75 Nomination Fee. This fee allows for Division discounts. When entered in the entire division a \$5 per class discount will apply. If a Division Class is Scratched then the discount for the division will not apply. Jumper Classics are part of the division and receive a \$100 discount if the whole division is entered. (Except USHJA Outreach Classes)
47. **COVID-19:** All competitors, trainers, staff and additional personal are required to adhere to ALL USEF, Murieta Equestrian Center, FoxFarms Inc. and California State, requirements and guidelines as they relate to COVID-19 and or the protection of everyone on the showgrounds. All waivers and forms must be completed before entering the show grounds, forms can be accessed at www.murietaautumnclassic.com.
48. **Equine Herpes Virus (EHV) & Vesicular Stomatitis (VS) :** All Competitors, Trainers, Owners, Staff and additional Personal are required to adhere to ALL USEF, Murieta Equestrian Center, FoxFarms Inc. and California State requirements and guidelines as they relate to EHV and or the protection of everyone on the showgrounds. All waivers and forms must be completed before entering the show grounds, forms can be accessed at www.murietaautumnclassic.com. Management may impose a Biosecurity fee.
If VS Protocols are in place, then horse(s) must arrive only between the hours of 12pm - 5pm on Monday and 8am - 5pm Tuesday - Sunday, by appointment only.

49. **SAFE SPORT STATEMENT:** Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

Management reserves the right to reduce the Prize Money offered in all Divisions & Featured Classes or cancel them. In addition, Featured Jumper Classes with fewer than 8, Management may reduce Prize Money offered. Notification of change or cancellation will be updated at www.murietaautumnclassic.com and will be posted at the show office. If Prize Money is reduced entry fee will also be reduced. Competitors may scratch without penalty.

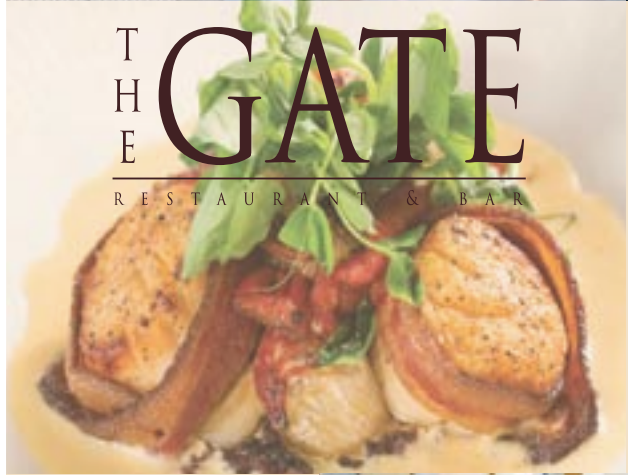

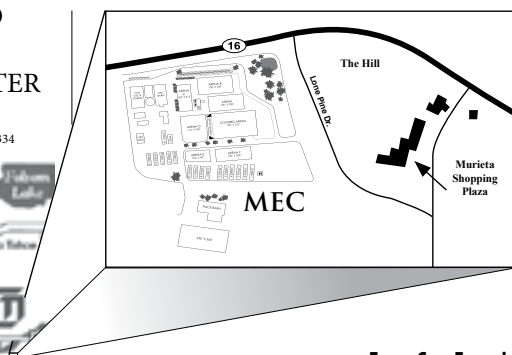
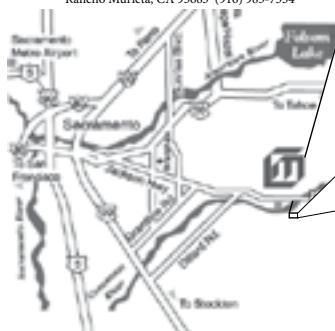
