

RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book & SAHJA Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Please see SAHJA Rule Book for specific class and medal specifications.
- MANAGEMENT: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and
 conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any
 kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management;
 its decision to be final.
- 3. RESPONSIBILITY: The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any Riders or Competitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to Competitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in Jumper classes as competition warrants and in compliance with all Federation rules.
- 4. CONDITION OF ENTRY: Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each Competitor shall hold the individual horse shows and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities, Federation, the Competition, FoxFarms Inc, Murieta Equestrian Center and Cosumnes Corp., and its employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of each horse show and the facilities at which each horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. All owners and Competitors shall be responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.
- 5. **STALLS: Trainers will be responsible for payment of all horse & tack stalls requested after entries due date has passed.** An open check or credit card authorization form is required to hold stalls. The Show Office handles all stall transactions and charges. Private transactions involving stalls are not permitted. Request for stalls for horses not entered in the show or for tack, feed or grooming may be reduced by management and refunds given. NO STRAW ALLOWED. Wood or Canvas construction: Top & bottom doors size stalls are 10 x 10, 10 X 12, 12 X 12 most with rubber matts. Anyone dismantling stalls or causing damage to a stall(s) will be charged a \$100 fee per panel, with a maximum fine of \$195 per stall.
- 6. **ENTRY PROCEDURES:** Entry blanks must be filled out completely, including all classes entered, signatures and organizational membership numbers. Entry Due Date is on each entry blank. After each Entry Due Date post entries are accepted as long as they are received one day prior to arrival and may be charged a processing fee. For each horse entered, a check or credit card for a deposit of \$200 must be included. All horses on he grounds must have a number, even non-showing horses. Numbers will not be issued without a check or credit card covering the balance of the entries.
 - Credit cards (Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express): Card holder will be charged an additional
 4% over the published rates as the rates shown in the Prize List are discounted for paying by cash, check or
 money order. If paying by credit card, upon receipt of the entry blank, and/or credit card authorization form,
 Horse Show Management will charge the credit card for the Competition registration fees. Credit cards shall
 be presented to Horse Show Management in the office before or at the time of close out. If such card is not
 presented or an alternative method of payment is not made, Rider/Trainer/Owner agrees that Horse Show
 Management is authorized to charge the credit card pursuant to the information contained in the entry blank at
 the conclusion of the Competition.
 - Cash, Check or Money Order Payments: The rates in this Prize List reflect the 4% discount if paying by cash, check or money order. If paying by check, cash, or money order please submit the required payment, made payable to FoxFarms, Inc., with a complete entry blank for each showing or non-showing entry, on or by the published Entries Due.
- 7. **OPEN ARENA FEE:** Allows Competitors to ride in the arenas before and after the show as available. Also, to lunge during the show in a desinated arena. Jumper rings close 1 hour before the start, and hunters 30 to 45 minutes before start of show.

- 8. **ENTRY BLANKS:** Care should be taken to enter each horse in its proper division or class. Competitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents completing entry blanks. In all cases the description on the entry blank must fully identify the horse. The word "entry" shall not be accepted.
 - A. Be properly signed, and in the case of a minor, be signed by a parent or guardian.
 - B. Be made on an entry blank provided by the show.
 - C. A show deposit of \$200 per horse must be included with entry.
 - D. Include signed MEC Release and Protocol's by rider, parent, trainer, groom and horse as required.
- 9. **REFUND POLICY:** All refund requests must be submitted in writing.
 - A. Before entries due all paid fees will be credited or refunded.
 - B. After entries due, the show and RV deposit will not be refunded.
 - C. After entries due, no refunds will be given unless you meet one of the following:
 - After the show starts, if a Competitor is ill or injured and cannot compete in the balance of the classes, that
 Competitor will be entitled to a refund of unused class fees provided the classes are officially scratched and a
 doctor's certificate is provided to the Horse Show Office prior to the close of the show.
 - After the show starts, if a horse is ill or injured classes scratched the same day they are scheduled receive a refund
 with an Official Show Veterinarian Certificate provided to the Horse Show Office prior to the close of the show.
 - D. No request for refunds will be accepted after the close of the show.
- 10. **RETURNED CHECKS:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled in the following procedure. 10% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH RETURNED CHECK OR MINIMUM OF \$50. Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash, or cash equivalent or they will be turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action.
- 11. **CREDIT CARD CHARGEBACK:** Chargebacks for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense. 20% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CREDIT CARD CHARGE WILL BE ASSESSED OR MINIMUM OF \$300.
- 12. UNPAID CHARGES: If the Show Management or Show Official (i.e. farrier, veterinarian, feed supplier, photographer, food concessionaire, etc.) must bill a Competitor/Owner for unpaid charges, a \$50 billing fee will be added to the amount due.
 - A. **Past unpaid balances** Competitor/Owner will be notified of any previous balance at the time of check-in. Outstanding balances must be paid prior to picking up show numbers. Horse Show Management reserves the right to require a deposit paid to cover all show expenses and any portion of the deposit that is unused will be mailed to the addressee on file no later than 15 days after the close of the show.
 - B. **Unpaid Balances** Competitor/Owner who do not come into the office to close out by 5pm at the end of the show forfeit the right to adjustments on any show charges. Final balances will be automatically charged to the payment method on file.
- 13. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: Horses arriving and/or departing before and/or after these dates & times will be billed \$25 per day per horse.
 - Classic I Arrive no earlier than Monday, 12pm February 12, 2024, Depart by 7pm Sunday, February 18, 2024.
 - Classic II Arrive no earlier than Monday, 12pm February 19, 2024, Depart by 7pm Sunday, February 25, 2024.
 - Classic III Arrive no earlier than Monday, 12pm February 26, 2024, Depart by 7pm Sunday, March 3, 2024.
 - Classic IV Arrive no earlier than Monday, 12pm March 4, 2024, Depart by 7pm Sunday, March 10, 2024.
- 14. PARKING: Horse trailers will be parked in designated areas. Autos will also be parked in designated areas. There will be no autos allowed in the barn area and aisles.
- 15. **RV's:** RV space is \$150 for the show (Friday, Saturday & Sunday), and must be requested on the entry blank by the Entry Due Date. The show will assign RV spaces and send conformation email with location. RV arriving early then Friday will be charged \$75 per day.

- 16. **FEED AND BEDDING:** All orders must be made through the Horse Show Office (916) 305-8898.
- 17. **MEDICAL WASTE:** Needles must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by Show Management.
- 18. MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal quardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or quardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, however boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or quardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 19. **NUMBERS:** Management will provide a number card for each competitor which shall be worn on the rider's back clearly visible to the judge at all times when in competition. Riders wearing the wrong number or no number at all may be eliminated from the class by the judge.
- 20. COURSES: Courses may consist of any combination of the following: Brush, Gate, Oxers, Panels, Post & Rails, Banks, Ditches, Coups, Logs, Barrels & Liverpools. The horse show management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads in jumper classes as competition warrants.
- 21. POLING: Not allowed in California.
- 22. HARD HATS: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/ SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly \ fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.
- 23. **SAFETY:** Accidents involving Competitors. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the Competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the Competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional.
- 24. DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
- 25. **HAUL INS** A \$50 haul-in fee per horse per day will be allowed at each show if the entry is received on or before "Entry Due Date" each week with a payment on file. After Entry Due Date only stalls will be available. Horses coming from VS Affected Counties will not be able to haul-in and will require a stall. Horses coming from an affected County will be required to meet VS Show Protocols which can be found at: www.theclassichorseshows.com

- 27.TIME SCHEDULE/POSTED ORDER: Each day by 7pm the next day's time schedule will be available on www.horseshowtime.com. This time schedule and/or posted orders will be strictly adhered to. All management decisions will be final.
- 28. **NON SHOWING POLICY:** For any horse on the grounds not officially entered, owner or trainer of said horse must complete a entry blank and write in the in the area of the Entry Blank used for classes "Non-Showing" and sign the entry blank at the Horse Show Office, pay a \$50 non showing fee. EMT Fee, and a stall fee.
- 29. TRAINER SPLITS: This service allows Trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until 5pm Saturday any splits after Saturday will subject to a \$5 office charge per entry. Only items billed by the horse show will be split. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected. FEED & BEDDING ORDERS AFTER 5pm FRIDAY WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE SPLIT AND WILL BE BILLED TO THE TRAINER.
- 30. **PRIZES/RIBBONS/PRIZE MONEY:** Prize to 1st place, Ribbons 1st 8th. Hunter & Jumper Prize Money 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.
- 31. **COVID-19:** All competitors, trainers, staff and additional personal are required to adhere to ALL Murieta Equestrian Center, FoxFarms Inc. and Sacramento County, requirements and guidelines as they relate to COVID-19 and or the protection of everyone on the showgrounds. All waivers and forms must be completed before entering the show grounds, forms can be accessed at www.northernwinterclassics.com.
- 32. **SAFETY & WELFARE:** All Entries must pay a \$38 Medic Standby.
